CAREER RESOURCES AND SERVICES FOR GEORGE MASON ALUMNI

As a service to alumni, **University Career Services** offers career planning and job search assistance.

Free services

- Use of Career Library resources, including computerized systems
- One-time Resume Critique Service (drop-off, fax, or email). See web site for the name of the consultant for your major.

- Initial consultation with career consultant for your major/field
- Participation in job fairs and networking events
- Referral to other appropriate University or community resources

Fee-based services

- **PatriotJobWeb registration** - provides access to a computerized listing of jobs, one-time fee of **\$10.00**.
- Consultation services: individual appointment with a career consultant - **\$20.00** per hour (after free initial appointment). Recent graduates (within six months of graduation) have access to individual consultations free of charge.
- Career Assessment: *Strong Interest Inventory Skills Confidence Edition* and *Myers Briggs Type Indicator*. **\$30.00** fee for each assessment or **\$50.00** if you choose to take both. The fee for recent graduates (who have graduated within the past six months) is **\$10.00** for each assessment.
