

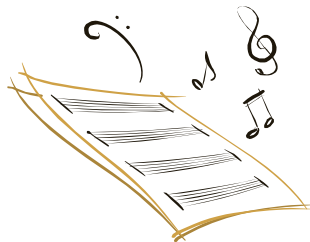

MEET THE CONDUCTORS



A product of the rich cultural life of Chicago, composer-conductor **MARK CAMPHOUSE** was born in Oak Park, Illinois in 1954. He holds undergraduate and graduate degrees in music from Northwestern University. Camphouse began composing at an early age, with the Colorado Philharmonic premiering his First Symphony when he was 17. His 19 published works for wind band (Alfred, Kjos, Southern and TRN Music Companies) have received

widespread critical acclaim and are performed widely in the US and abroad. Principal commissions include those by the John P. Paynter Foundation, William D. Revelli Foundation, Bands of America, Inc., The United States Army Band, The United States Marine Band, Northshore Concert Band, and some of America's finest college, high school, and community bands.

Mr. Camphouse has served as a guest conductor, lecturer and clinician in 40 states, Canada and Europe. He was elected to membership in the American Bandmasters Association in 1999 and has served as coordinator of the National Band Association Young Composer Mentor Project since 2000. He was featured recently in a nationally broadcast interview on NPR's "Weekend America", focusing on his composition entitled A Movement for Rosa. The work honors late Civil Rights heroine Rosa Parks on the occasion of the 50th anniversary of her single act of courage sparking the modern Civil Rights movement. He is Professor of Music at George Mason University where he conducts the wind symphony and teaches courses in conducting and composition, having previously served as Director of Bands at Radford University in Virginia from 1984-2006. Virginia Governor Mark Warner presented Professor Camphouse with a 2002 Outstanding Faculty Award, sponsored by the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia. This award is the Commonwealth's highest honor for faculty at Virginia's colleges and universities for demonstrated excellence in teaching, research, and public service. Mark Camphouse has been married to soprano Elizabeth Ann Curtis since 1982. They have twin daughters, Beth and Briton.



JOHN E. CASAGRANDE joined the faculty of George Mason University as Adjunct Professor of Music in the fall of 1997, where he is currently Director of the Instrumental Music Education program. Prior to his appointment, he served as Director of Bands at W.T. Woodson High School from 1982-2000, Mount Vernon High School from 1978-1982, East Stroudsburg (PA) from 1968-1978 and in the Wissahickon (PA) schools from 1963-1968. Receiving both

his bachelor's and master's degrees from Ithaca College, Casagrande has also done graduate study at Temple University, West Chester University, Hartt School of Music, Peabody Conservatory, the University of Virginia, and George Mason University. His honors include election to the American Bandmasters Association and the American School Band Directors Association; four "Citations of Excellence" from the National Band Association; the Sudler Flag of Honor; the "Mac Award" from First Chair of America, "Who's Who in American Education"; five awards for 'Professional Excellence' from the Fairfax County School Board; W.T. Woodson High School "Teacher of the Year;" and finalist for Fairfax County's "Teacher of the Year" award.
