FRESHMAN AND SOPHOMORE RECOMMENDED COURSE SEQUENCE

This sequence emphasizes general education and theater core requirements in the freshman and sophomore semesters, allowing for enrollment in more upper level theater courses in the junior and senior years. Students may choose a sequence that more evenly balances general education and theater major requirements throughout their four years.
